

The Ethiopian press agency ENA said the power stations will be built on the Genale River, in the south and another in the northern state of Amhara. EEPCO says that the two projects are worth some USD 960 million. The projects will be executed by the "China Gezhouba Group Company" (CGGC) and "Sinohydro Corporation", both are part of a 25 year government development plan valued at USD 12 billion.

The wind power facilities are being planned according to the same framework: the preliminary accord commits "Hydro China" to build in the areas of Adama and Mesobo Harena.
